Policy Scope

This policy applies to all College of Allied Health Professions (CAHP) students.

Policy Definitions

Cost of Attendance (COA) (<https://www.unmc.edu/student-success/financial-aid/cost-of-attendance.html>) – sometimes referred to as student budgets, is intended to provide students with estimated/reasonable program costs. Student budgets are intended to cover the cost of the student only.
