

APPLIED HEALTH INFORMATICS

The purpose of the **Certificate in Applied Health Informatics** is to provide healthcare professionals with an academic foundation in health informatics, focusing on preparing current and future healthcare professionals with the skills necessary to effectively apply health informatics in practice to improve the quality and safety of patient care. The online certificate curriculum includes four core courses (12 credit hours). A student earning the certificate must successfully complete all four courses (12 credit hours). Students completing the certificate program may elect to continue their studies to earn a Master of Healthcare Delivery Science.
