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**Purpose**

Establishes compliance and immunization requirements.

**Scope**

This policy applies to professional graduate students.

**Policy**

Upon admission to the professional graduate program and on December 1 of each year, the professional graduate student must provide evidence according to the UNMC Student handbook of:

- a. Health Information Privacy and Protection Act (HIPAA) training.
- b. Blood-borne pathogens training.
- c. Current Registered Nurse license.
- d. Current Hepatitis B immunization and/or a reactive Hepatitis B titer.
- e. Annual completion of a test for tuberculosis.
- f. Annual flu immunization.
- g. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation for Health Care Providers certificate that will remain current through each semester the student is enrolled.
- h. Background check.
- i. Drug screening when required by clinical agency.
